The Wave Stitch Wall Hanging

Size:

Approximately 30"L and 11"W

Materials:

1 Skein of Lion Brand Fast-Track in color Chopper Grey Approximately 149 yards of super bulky weight yarn Size US 13 9mm needles

Abbreviations:

K = knit YO = yarn over

Pattern:

- Cast on 36 stitches
- Row 1, Knit All
- Row 2, K 6, * YO 1x, K1, YO 2x, K1, YO 3x, K1, YO 2x, K1, YO 1x, K6 * (Repeat pattern between the * * asterisks)
- Row 3, K 6, * Drop 1 St, K1, Drop 2 St, K1, Drop 3 St, K1, Drop 2 St, K1, Drop 1 St, K6 * (Repeat pattern between the * * asterisks)
- Row 4, Knit All
- Row 5, Knit All
- Row 6, K1, * YO 1x, K1, YO 2x, K1, YO 3x, K1, YO 2x, K1, YO 1x, K6 * (repeat pattern within asterisks, ending your last repeat with K1)
- Row 7, K 1, * Drop 1 St, K1, Drop 2 St, K1, Drop 3 St, K1, Drop 2 St, K1, Drop 1 St, K6 * (repeat pattern within asterisks, ending your last repeat with K1)





• Row 8, Knit All Repeat Rows 1 - 8 until your piece measures approximately 30 inches or until there is enough yarn left to bind off and attach the piece to a dowel, then Bind Off (or if you choose to not bind off, just slide the stitches onto a dowel)

Tip: Pull on work to straighten and lengthen the yarn overs and waves as you knit the wall hanging.



Assembly: Optional


After binding off, attach the piece to a wooden dowel using left over yarn and a crochet hook.

Lay the dowel on top of the bind off edge, insert the crochet hook into the first bind off stitch, grab the yarn with the hook and pull back through the bind off stitch (2 stitches on hook), then move the hook over the top of the dowel and grab the yarn with the hook, pull yarn through both stitches on hook. Repeat until all bind off stitches are

attached to dowel.

This gives the wall hanging a finished, put together look.
