

# Minimalist Knit Plant Hanger

Size:

Approximately 8 1/4"W by 29"L

## Materials:

1 Skein of Bernat Maker

Homedec yarn in cream

OR

Approximately 100 yards of bulky weight yarn

2 25mm beads

Size 6mm or similar needles

Yarn needle

## Abbreviations:

K1 = Knit one

S1wyif = Slip one with yarn in front

## Pattern:

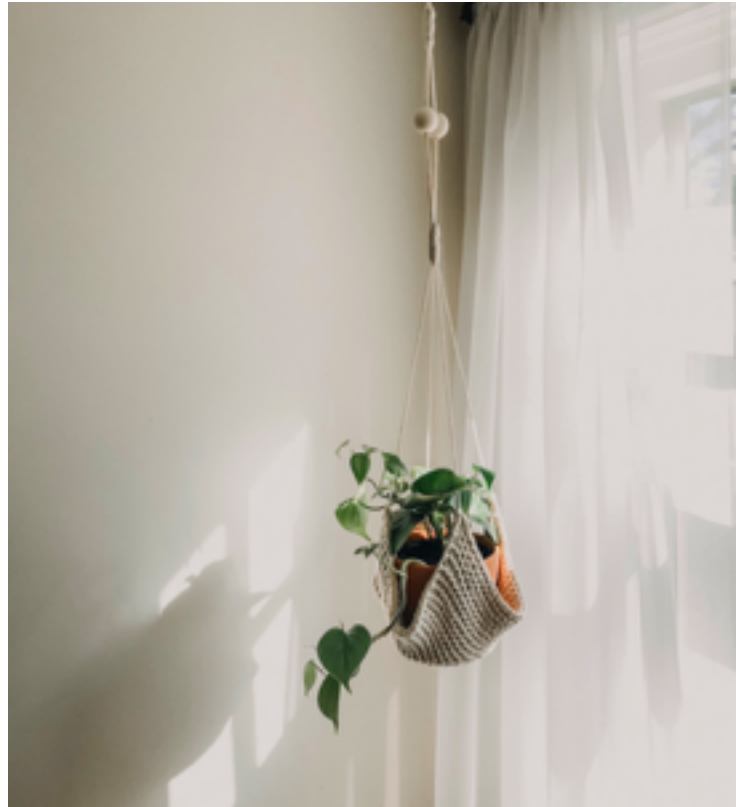
- Using the long tail cast on technique, cast on 36 stitches
- Row 1 - K1wyif, move yarn to back, knit remaining stitches
- Repeat row 1 for approximately 8 1/4"
- Bind off
- Weave in ends

Cut 2 strands approximately 48" long

Cut 2 strands approximately 15" long

## Assembly:

- Place the 2 longer strands together and fold them in half
- Thread 1 end of the 2 strands through 1 bead and the other end through the other bead
- Tie each end of the strands to each corner of the knit square



- Attach 1 of the 15" strands 5" from the top of the plant hanger by tying a knot around all 4 strands of the hanger. Wrap the strand around, moving downward, until the wrapped yarn covers approximately 1" of the hanger, then move back upward wrapping a second layer around the hanger. Thread the end of the strand through a yarn needle and weave it down through the center of the wrapped yarn to secure it in place
- Repeat that with the second 15" strand a few inches below the beads
