

The Big Wave Wall Hanging

Size:

Approximately 25.5"L and 34.5"W

Materials:

7 Skeins of Premier Couture Jazz
100g yarn in Milk

OR

1 Skein of Premier Couture Jazz
500g yarn in milk and 2 skeins of
Premier Couture Jazz 100g yarn in
milk

Premieryarns.com

Approximately 115 yards of jumbo weight
yarn

Size US50 25mm needles

Abbreviations:

K1 = Knit one

YO = Yarn over

YOx2 =Yarn over two times, etc

Pattern:

- Cast on 36 stitches (I use long tail cast on)
- Row 1 - Knit
- Row 2 - *K6, yo, k1, yox2, k1, yox3, k1, yox2, k1, yo, k6, repeat from * to end
- Row 3 - *K6, drop 1 yo, k1, drop 2 yo's, k1, drop 3 yo's, k1, drop 2 yo's, k1, drop 1 yo, k6, repeat from * to end
- Rows 4-5 - Knit
- Row 6 - *K1, yo, k1, yox2, k1, yox3, k1, yox2, k1, yo, k1 repeat from * to end
- Row 7 - *K1, drop 1 yo, k1, drop 2 yo's, k1, drop 3 yo's, k1, drop 2 yo's, k1, drop 1 yo repeat from * to end
- Rows 8-9 - Knit
- Row 10 - *K6, yo, k1, yox2, k1, yox3, k1, yox2,



- k1, yo, k6, repeat from * to end
- Row 11 - *K6, drop 1 yo, k1, drop 2 yo's, k1, drop 3 yo's, k1, drop 2 yo's, k1, drop 1 yo, k6, repeat from * to end
 - Rows 12-13 - Knit
 - Row 14 - *K1, yo, k1, yox2, k1, yox3, k1, yox2, k1, yo, k1 repeat from * to end
 - Row 15 - *K1, drop 1 yo, k1, drop 2 yo's, k1, drop 3 yo's, k1, drop 2 yo's, k1, drop 1 yo repeat from * to end
 - Rows 16-17 - Knit
 - Row 18 - *K6, yo, k1, yox2, k1, yox3, k1, yox2, k1, yo, k6, repeat from * to end
 - Row 19 - *K6, drop 1 yo, k1, drop 2 yo's, k1, drop 3 yo's, k1, drop 2 yo's, k1, drop 1 yo, k6, repeat from * to end
 - Rows 20-21 - Knit
 - Row 22 - *K1, yo, k1, yox2, k1, yox3, k1, yox2, k1, yo, k1 repeat from * to end
 - Row 23 - *K1, drop 1 yo, k1, drop 2 yo's, k1, drop 3 yo's, k1, drop 2 yo's, k1, drop 1 yo repeat from * to end
 - Rows 24-25 - Knit
 - Row 26 - Using the dowel as your right needle, knit all stitches off of the needles onto the dowel
 - Cut the tail and weave into the back side of the wall hanging
 - Weave in all ends



TIPS:

- This stitch takes some finessing to get it to look just right. Pull on all the dropped yarn overs as you knit the rows and after the project is complete.
- I attached each new skein with a knot and trimmed the excess at the end. If you choose, you can add each skein without the knot. Simply begin knitting with the new skein and weave in the ends at the end of the project.
- You can use the left over yarn to hang the piece on the wall or cut the tail, weave in the end and hang the dowel on 2 nails (like in the pictures).
